**KEY TO PLANT TERMS:** **HEIRLOOM:** Old fashioned open pollinated varieties with a history of being passed down through generations. **OP (OPEN POLLINATED):** Plants produce seed that is true to type (if properly isolated from other varieties). **HYBRID:** Developed through deliberate crossing of 2 different varieties of the same species. **I = INDETERMINATE:** Climbing/vining. Keep producing new shoots and blossoms even after fruit set. Vigorous plants need to be staked or trellised. Fruit ripens over an extended period. **D = DETERMINATE:** Bush habit, with short vines that grow little once fruit is set. Fruit ripens within a concentrated period. Can be grown with or without staking. **S = SEMI-DETERMINATE:** Plants grow moderately tall (3 - 5 feet) and may require some staking. Produce for an extended period, but not as vigorous as Indeterminates. \* = Stout Oak Farm Tomato Tasting Winners!

	Brussels Sprouts	Tall plants produce excellent quality bright green sprouts. 100 days to maturity. Harvest in the late fall, after a frost.	Hybrid
	Swiss Chard, Rainbow	Gorgeous dark green leaves with brilliant red, pink, white, yellow, and orange stems. Strong, upright plants.	OP
	Kale, Red Russian	Kate's favorite! Blue-green leaves with bright purple stems. Tall plants produce all season long. Our sweetest, tenderest kale.	OP
	Kale, Lacinato	Popular Tuscan-type, a.k.a. 'Dinosaur' kale. Very dark green leaves with savoyed/wrinkly texture. Makes delicious kale salads	OP
	Kale, Curly Green	Classic curly green kale! Vigorous 2' to 3' tall plants with curly blue-green leaves. Best kale for soups and kale chips!	OP
	Lettuce, Green or Red	Easy to grow greenleaf and redleaf lettuces. Slow to bolt. <i>Harvest Tip</i> : Pick your lettuce in the early morning for best flavor.	OP
<b>Herbs &amp; Flowers</b>	Basil	Traditional Italian culinary basil. Plants are 24 - 30" tall with 3" long leaves. Keep harvesting to encourage new shoots.	OP
	Cilantro	Flavorful leaves! Get multiple harvests from these fast growing plants. If left to flower, they'll produce coriander seeds.	Heirloom
	Parsley	Italian flat-leaf type parsley with dark green glossy leaves. Very flavorful! Excellent for sauces and pestos.	OP
	Cosmos	'Sensation Mix' - Single flowers, 3-4" across, in lavender, pink, magenta and white. Annual plants grow to be at least 48" tall.	OP
	Marigolds	<i>Tagetes patula</i> . French marigold. Large yellow blooms on bushy dark green plants. 12-18" tall. Natural pest deterrent.	OP
	Nasturtium	'Jewel Mix' of yellow, orange, red, + pink flowers on trailing plants. Delicate, lily pad shaped leaves. Edible flowers + foliage.	OP
	Zinnias, Benary's Giant	Bright mix of yellow, orange, white, lilac, coral, and burgandy. Long stems. Tall plants bloom all summer. Abundant color!	OP
<b>Onions &amp; Leeks</b>	Yellow Onion	Reliable yellow storage onion, typically between baseball and softball size. Excellent keeper, stores well through the winter.	OP
	Red Onion	'Red Wethersfield' heirloom from CT. Flavorful red storage onion. Grow extra and store them for winter!	Heirloom
	King Richard Leek	Tall slender leeks for late summer or fall harvest. Sweet, mild flavor. Beautiful plants with medium green leaves.	OP
<b>Beans</b>	Green Bean, bush	'Provider' bush beans are crisp + delicious! Heavy producer of 5"-6" beans for fresh eating or canning. Bush habit - no staking.	OP
	Green Bean, pole	'Kentucky Wonder' pole beans will need a fence or trellis to climb on. Excellent producer of tasty 7"-9" stringless pods.	Heirloom
